Application Guideline

Please read the following information and instructions carefully before completing the application. Your written application and supporting materials are of primary importance in the selection process. They offer you an opportunity to describe your background, academic ability, accomplishments and plans for the future. We ask that you give as complete a picture of yourself as possible.

Your application is thoroughly evaluated and an admission decision is made only after thoughtful consideration of all the information provided.

Prerequisites

To be considered for admission into the A Level programme, all prospective candidates must meet the following prerequisites:

- SLC or equivalent in any discipline from a recognized Board/University.
- Ability to speak, read, write and comprehend English fluently.

Admission Procedure

Prospective participants in our A Level programme are required to appear in a computer based entrance examination and interview.

Participants will be offered admission based on the Admissions Committee's assessment of the prospective participant's past academic performance, entrance examination, performance in the interview and ability to contribute to the programme. The entrance examination will consist of computer based English language aptitude test and quantitative aptitude test. The applicants will have to produce original mark-sheets and certificates at the time of admission. Copies of official transfer/character certificates from the school/institute last attended and migration certificate in original need to be submitted at the time of admission.

Admission Policies

The Admissions Committee will not consider any additional materials or changes once an application has been submitted. The completed application becomes confidential property of Ace Institute of Management and is not returnable. Applicants are responsible for ensuring that all the information and accompanying material provided

in connection with their application is authentic and accurate.

Ace Institute of Management may at any time require applicants to provide satisfactory verification of the information and documents submitted as part of their application. If an applicant is unable to do so, the Institute reserves the right to cease consideration of the applications, to withdraw any offer of admission already made and/or to terminate one's status as a student.

The applicant will assume all costs for authenticating and verifying documents and information associated with his/her application.

Submission Instructions

It is your responsibility to ensure that your application is complete. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. The Admissions Committee will not consider any additional materials or changes once an application has been submitted. The following application materials must be submitted to Ace in a sealed envelope:

- Duly completed application form together with 2 colour passport-size photographs.
- Certified copies of all relevant academic qualifications and transcripts/marks sheets of the final examination of class eight, nine and ten.
- Application processing fee of NRs. 500/-

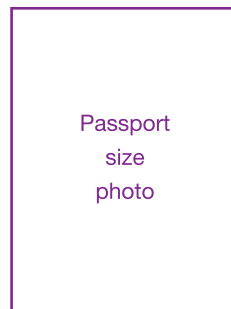
